- The student must submit a typed essay (minimum of 500 words). Essay topic on application.
- The student must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. (4.00 scale).
- The student must submit a copy of high school transcript.
- The student must submit a copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited college (two or four-year college).

The scholarship administrator will review all applications and make its recommendations by 6/18/2018. Scholarship recipients will be notified shortly there afterward. Only on-time, completed application packages will be considered. Completed Application packages must be post marked by 6/1/2018.
