Recipient will receive a \$500.00 scholarship payable to an accredited post-secondary institution. Scholarship recipient must show proof of acceptance at an accredited institution.

CRITERIA

Each applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible.

- **Be a high school graduate;**
- **Demonstrate leadership ability and has engaged in community services;**
- **Submit an application and two (2) letters of recommendations. (The recommendations may come from a school, community, or church representative or an employer, (no relatives);**
- **Submit a typed essay (minimum of 500 words). (Essay topics are on application.);**
- **Have a minimum 2.5 GPA (4.00 scale);**
- **Submit a copy of high school transcript;**
- **Submit a copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited institution (two or four year college).**

PLEASE INCLUDE THE ABOVE INFORMATION IN ONE COMPLETE PACKAGE.

Application packages will be graded on neatness, grammatical structure, incorrect spellings, etc.

The scholarship committee will review all applications and make its recommendations by 7/15/19. Scholarship recipients will be notified shortly thereafter. **Only on time, completed application packages will be considered. Completed Application packages must be post marked by 6/15/19.**
